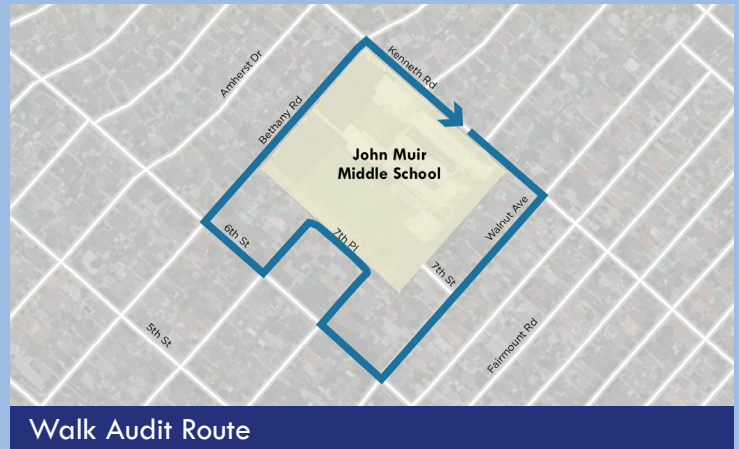

SUMMARY

Project team staff walked around the school with school and city staff and parents to identify barriers and challenges for students walking and biking to and from John Muir Middle School. During the workshop following the walk, project team staff documented participants' concerns and discussed possible solutions.

GENERAL FEEDBACK

- Too many parents use Kenneth Road for morning drop-offs and Kenneth Road and 7th Street for afternoon pickups, creating traffic around both entrances. Meanwhile, the entrance to the school on Bethany Road is lightly patronized.
- Improved crossing facilities are needed along Kenneth Road, including continental crosswalks and crossing guards.
- Around 90% of children are driven to school by their parents.
- Drivers drive recklessly around the school, with many speeding, making illegal u-turns and double-parking.
