

- 2. ALIGNMENT LINE #2 MUST BE A MINIMUM OF 10 FEET FROM ALIGNMENT LINE #1. AT SIGNALIZED INTERSECTIONS, ALIGNMENT LINE #2 MUST BE WITHIN 5 FEET OF A CROSSWALK PUSH BUTTON.
- 3. LONGITUDINAL LINES NEAR GUTTER MAY HAVE LENGTH REDUCED
- 4. LONGITUDINAL LINES SHALL BE CENTERED AT LANE LINES AND AT MIDPOINT OF TRAVEL LANES.
- 5. CURB LANES OR APPROACHES WITH ONE TRAVEL LANE SHALL HAVE LONGITUDINAL LINES SEPARATED BY 3 FEET, EDGE TO EDGE (5 FEET, CENTER TO CENTER)

ALIGNMENT LINES SHALL BE PARALLEL TO STREET CENTERLINE.

LONGITUDINAL LINES SHALL BE 2 FEET WIDE. LONGITUDINAL LINES SHALL HAVE LENGTH INCREASED TO ENSURE CURB RAMPS ARE WITHIN ALIGNMENT LINES.

STOP LINES SHALL BE INSTALLED PER BURBANK STANDARD PLAN BT-411-1.
